- To ensure gender balance at all levels of the church and on committees, task groups, etc.
- To promote the implementation of the Diocesan Policy on Inclusive Language.
- To encourage all parishes (including the Cathedral and worship centres) to use inclusive language in liturgy and resources.

About the Women's Ministry Task Group

History

The establishment of the Women's Ministry Task Group (WMTG) was agreed to by the Synod in 2004 when the Clergy Women's Task Group (CMTG) disbanded.

In July 2005 the Administrator, in the absence of a Bishop, appointed the members of the Task Group. The Group first met in August 2005 and have met regularly since that time.
